Each swing is hand sculptured from an old car tyre into an appealing animal shape. Most popular are the horse and reindeer (especially with Christmas coming), however the elephant and shark are also popular.

They started off in their backyard, however they are in the process of moving into a factory in Brunswick so they can keep up with demand.

These are not your typical "backyard" product. Their swings are created from the designs of a retired US marble sculptor, who has been manufacturing them in the US for over 10 years. They have been independently tested in a UK laboratory and independently checked to conform to Australian Standards.

Being made from old car tyres, they not only help the environment, but are strong and durable. They are also suitable for indoors as well as outdoors.

With Christmas not that far away, they make an ideal gift for a child and a novel sculpture and conversation piece for the backyard.
