SHORT FORM INSTRUCTIONS



Congratulations on your purchase of Datadesk's NoteBoard.

Thank you for choosing the NoteBoard. We think that You'll find the NoteBoard to be an innovative addition to your notebook computer. With the NoteBoard, you gain the comfort of a full-sized keyboard without giving up valuable desktop space. The NoteBoard also makes a great addition to a desktop computer system.

Setting Up the NoteBoard

1. Positioning the NoteBoard

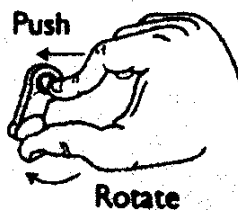
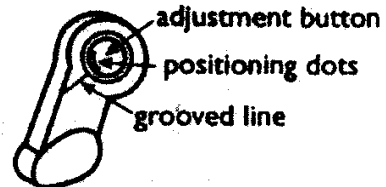
Adjust the NoteBoard's feet so that it stands over your notebook keyboard without touching the notebook. Follow Step 2 to adjust the height of the feet to a level that is comfortable for you. You can either adjust the feet so they are all at the same level or make the front feet slightly lower.

2. Adjusting the feet

It is important to position the NoteBoard high

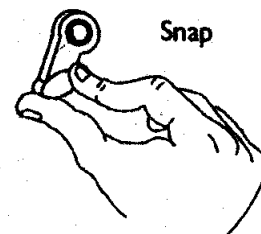
enough over your notebook so that it does not touch your notebook's keyboard. You can do this by adjusting the NoteBoard's feet to one of six heights.

To adjust the feet, simply push in the round adjustment button at the base of the foot and turn the foot to the desired position.



Match the grooved line on the foot with one of the small positioning dots on the

adjustment button. Each dot represents one of positions. The sixth position is achieved by tucking the feet under the notebook, for a flat position. Release your finger from the button and gently move the foot until you hear it snap into place. If the

NoteBoard "rocks" or is unstable, check the feet to make sure that they are all adjusted to the same level. If you are positioning the front feet lower, make sure that the front feet are at the same level, and that the back feet are also level with each other.

Warning: Do not attempt to adjust the feet without pushing in the button at the base of each foot.

3. Connecting the NoteBoard to your computer.

Turn off your computer and plug you NoteBoard into your notebook's PS/2 (keyboard) port (the small port with 5 pins). If you also wish to use an external mouse, this can be connected to your serial port (via an adaptor) or you can use a laptop splitter cable (or "Y" cable) to enable you to connect both your PS/2 mouse and the NoteBoard to a single PS/2 port.

If you are using the NoteBoard on a desktop system, plug the NoteBoard into the PS/2 port. If your desktop computer does not have a PS/2 port, you will need a PS/2-to-AT adapter

All these adaptors are available wherever computer accessories are sold.

Warning: Always turn your computer OFF before connecting or disconnecting your NoteBoard.

Note: Some ThinkPad computers require a special adapter to connect any external keyboard. You can order this adapter from DataDesk Technologies by calling 206-812-5480 or emailing support@data-desk.com.
